CAIB to CIP Credit Transfer Form

With a completed CAIB designation, applicants are eligible for three (3) credits. CAIB graduates will receive credit for C11 - Principles & Practice of Insurance (Mandatory course), C130 - Essential Skills for the Insurance Broker/Agent (Applied Professional course) and one (1) unspecified Elective course*.

Credits granted will be recognized as transfer credits only and will not be assigned a grade. This may affect qualification for an Honours CIP certificate and a student's chance at winning a CIP prize.

Credit Fees: C11 = \$98.70 / C130 = \$52.50 / 1 unspecified elective = \$52.50 **Total cost \$203.70 (incl.GST)**

Note Fees will increase on Aug. 1, 2016.

Only two (2) credits will be available if the candidate has already completed course C11.
