Chair's Message

It is finally starting to feel like Spring outside, and with it comes the exciting prospect of spending more time outside and weekends away (if we ever find the time!). It's time once again to say "out with the old and in with the new." This is true of the new season, but also in relation to my position on council. After six eventful years, my term as Chair of the Cambrian Shield Chapter of the Insurance Institute is nearing its end.

It's a great opportunity to reflect on how much progress we have made as a council: for starters, we currently have over 20 committed councilors and volunteers lending their time, energy and ideas to our activities. This includes great representation across the different regions of our Chapter, to ensure no matter where you live, there is someone in your local area championing your educational needs.

While the CIP course registrations have been consistent over the years, our seminar and events programs have really taken off. In addition to the two-week licensing courses hosted each year, in 2008-2009 we arranged over 12 seminar offerings across the different cities. For some time now we have also been offering on-line CIP courses and webinars to overcome the geographical challenges posed by our province.

In terms of what's new, 23 students progressed through our two-week licensing courses in 2008. The pass ratio remained over 91%, and one of last year's students won the top mark in Ontario, so we are very proud of this local course offered to benefit our members locally.

Convocations have always presented a fantastic opportunity to recognize the top academic achievers in the Chapter each year. Our biggest event – without doubt – is now our Annual Curling Bonspiel. What started as a small networking event is now into its sixth year, and has grown on a grand scale. Last October saw 80 curlers take to the ice for some fun and friendly competition, followed by Halloween-inspired pumpkin carving and dinner. With space for only 4 more teams, some anticipate a sell-out this year! Register your team as soon as you can!

Without pausing for breath, we have lots on offer for Spring – all the specific details can be found later in the newsletter. For those continuing their CIP courses, there are 8 Web-based CIP course on offer starting soon!

At the end of April we are hosting a webinar on "ezITV – Insurance to Value" for all those brokers who use this rating software.

We are again looking to book dates for the "Boating Safety" course before we all get back on the lakes. This will be followed once again by our licensing course – the upcoming session will be held in North Bay.

Our programs seem to be generating a renewed enthusiasm in our industry, reflected in the increased participation and membership of our Chapter. For each year of being Chair, I would like to thank my Councils and my Chapter Managers – without them none of this would have been possible. I look forward to working with my successor in the near future, and would encourage anyone that wants to become involved with the Chapter to attend our Annual General Meeting on June 16, 2009!

Committee Members wins Top Awards


