The **Rhind Bursary Program** offers two bursaries awarded annually. The bursaries cover the full cost of tuition, textbooks and exams for one course in the intended program.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

For all tiers, applicants must:

- Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident.
- Submit a completed application form.

THREE CASCADING TIERS

TIER LEVEL	CRITERIA CANDIDATES MUST BE/SUBMIT:
TIER 1 CIP Society members pursuing their FCIP, ACIP or CMGA designations, not otherwise supported by their employer	Currently employed in the P&C insurance industry. Currently pursuing the FCIP, ACIP or CMGA designation program. Academic record, with a minimum of C average in the CIP program. Letter of reference from CIP instructor or employer. Letter to confirm that employer does not provide financial support for this education.
TIER 2 CIP Society members pursuing an Insurance Institute certificate program, not otherwise supported by their employer	Currently employed in the P&C insurance industry. Currently pursuing the Risk Management, Commercial Insurance or MGA certificate program. Academic record with a minimum of C average in the CIP program. Letter of reference from CIP instructor or employer. Letter to confirm that employer does not provide financial support for this education.
TIER 3 Dependents of a CIP Society member, who are pursuing their CIP designation, not otherwise supported by their employer	Academic record with a minimum of B average or equivalent in most recent academic year. A letter of reference from the CIP Society member who is sponsoring the applicant. Letter to confirm that employer does not provide financial support for this education (if applicable).
