TIER 2 CIP Society members enrolled in insurance-related professional development which is not otherwise supported by employer	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Currently employed in the P&C insurance industry.• Currently enrolled in an insurance-related professional development program such as the Risk Management Certificate.• Academic record with a minimum of C average in the CIP program.• Letter of reference from CIP instructor or employer.• Letter to confirm that employer does not provide financial support for education.
TIER 3 Dependents of CIP Society member who are pursuing post-secondary education in a field that focuses directly on, or that would impact significantly on, the P&C insurance industry and/or related financial services	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Currently enrolled in a P&C insurance-related post-secondary education program.• Academic record with a minimum of B average or equivalent in most recent academic year.• A letter of reference from the CIP Society member who is sponsoring the applicant.
